Toddler Play-group

Where two year olds can grow in social and language skills. Two hours of learning vocabulary, playing, singing, listening, and "reading".

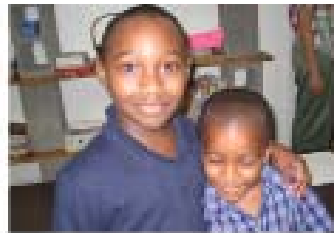


After-school Enrichment

Parent Education

Jonestown Fitness and Health Club

Girls to Women

Where young girls ages 8-12 learn about puberty, personal hygiene, problem-solving, communication skills, and self-esteem.
